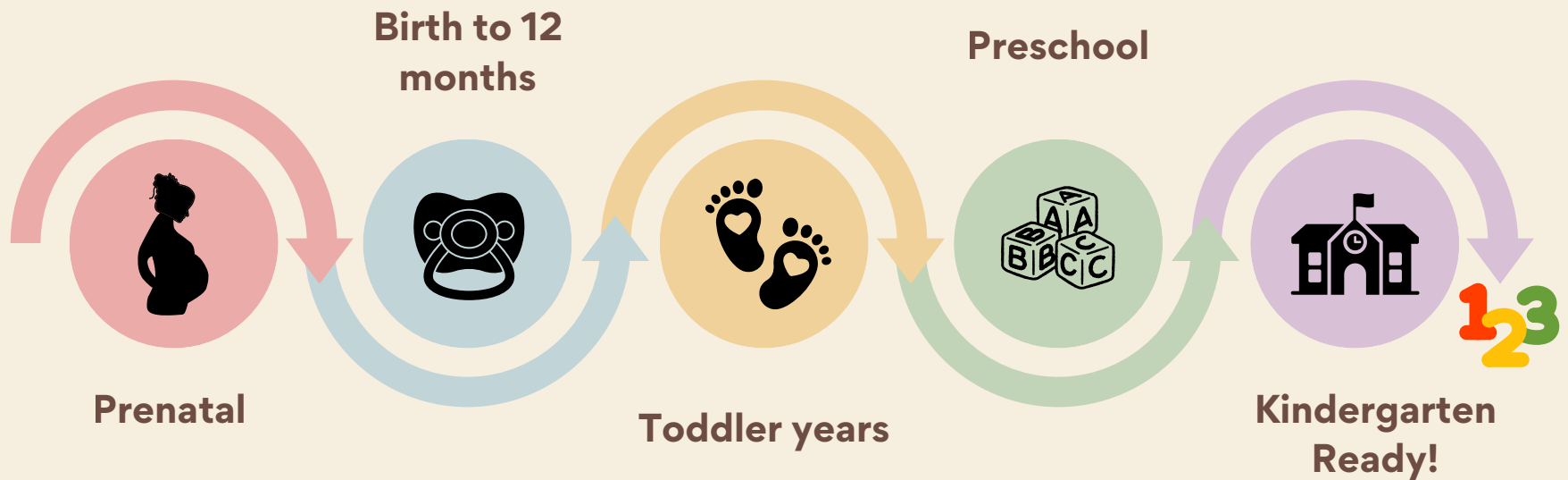

- Schedule 1st Dental Visit
- Come to a Reading to Read Storytime or other program at the Library

12-18 Months



- Keep checking on those milestones!
- Safety for the Curious Toddler
- Social Communication Growth Charts
- Remember to get your child's lead levels tested at their 1-2-3 year old well-child checks!

18-24 Months



- Keep up with the well-child visits and immunizations!
- Make sure your child is getting quality childcare
- Feeding and Nutrition tips
- Refer to General Resources above for positive discipline tips!
- Come to a Reading to Read Storytime or other program at the Library

2-3 Years



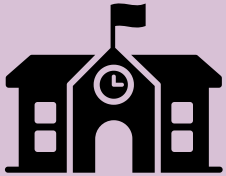
- Keep checking those milestones!

4-5 Years



- Get your little one ready for Kindergarten!!
- Make sure vaccines are up to date - will need these for Kindergarten!
- Verify what school district your child attend.
