As of November 2024, the Springfield Tool Library is now the "Laverne Schell Tool Library" in honor of the late Laverne Schell, a beloved and dedicated volunteer who was committed to CPO and its mission to create resilient children, healthy families, and strong neighborhoods and communities.





Throughout the past year,

154 loans were completed with 64 different tools.

Through multiple generous donations, the Laverne Schell Tool Library now has 293 tools in its inventory.





REVENUE AND EXPENSES



Revenues

The Tool Library's source of income is memberships. In July 2024 - June 2025, the Tool Library received **\$1,039.36** in membership fees.

Expenses

The Tool Library's primary expense is liability insurance. In July 2024 - June 2025, the Tool Library paid **\$2,022.56** in expenses.
